### GENERAL INFORMATION

Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>be enrolled in a Health School at a partner Foreign Education Institution;</li> <li>have an excellent academic record;</li> <li>be in the last year of the course.</li> </ul>
Language Proficiency	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Medical Internship / Speech Therapy / Occupational Therapy / Physical Therapy: Portuguese Proficiency is required: B1 level or higher.</li> <li>To attend the Medical Electives: depend on the elective (most of them are offered to English speakers).</li> </ul>
Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>USP is a public state Institution that receives exchange students at <b>no cost</b>.</li> </ul>
Restaurants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All exchange students have access to the university restaurants (RS 2,00 per meal)</li> </ul>
Accommodation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>FMUSP does not provide free housing facilities for international students. The search for accommodation must be carried out by the students. VISA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Student VISA (VITEM IV) - for the students who will stay more than 90 days at FMUSP;</li> <li>Visitor VISA (VIVIS) - for the students who will stay less than 90 days. Some countries have visa exemptions</li> </ul>
Health Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All the accepted students (more or less than 90 days) must send us, via e-mail, a copy of a health insurance that covers any eventual need</li> </ul>

## NOMINATION AND APPLICATION PROCESS

<p><b>How to apply</b></p>	<p>The exchange application for undergraduate students is entirely online, through our application system (called <b>Mundus</b>).</p> <p>The student must contact the international office of his/ her Home Institution and ask them to send us a nomination via e-mail (douglas.bartholomeu@fm.usp.br). This first nomination consists in a single e-mail containing the student's name, his/her e-mail, exact period and the Institution's address.</p> <p>Once our office receives this nomination, the student will receive an e-mail containing a link to Mundus platform and instructions to complete his/her application: fill out personal information, select courses and upload some documents.</p> <p>The applications submitted will be analyzed by FMUSP International Office and forwarded to our Undergraduate Commission for evaluation in the following days after the deadline (around 30 days).</p> <p>If the student is accepted, we are going to communicate the student and his/her home Institution and send the acceptance letter via e-mail.</p> <p>Unfortunately, we cannot any guarantee that we will be able to arrange the elective, even if the student is from one of our partner universities or when he/she has been selected by his/her Home University. It all depends on the available capacity at FMUSP and for each individual request we will have to contact the department(s) of preference.</p>
