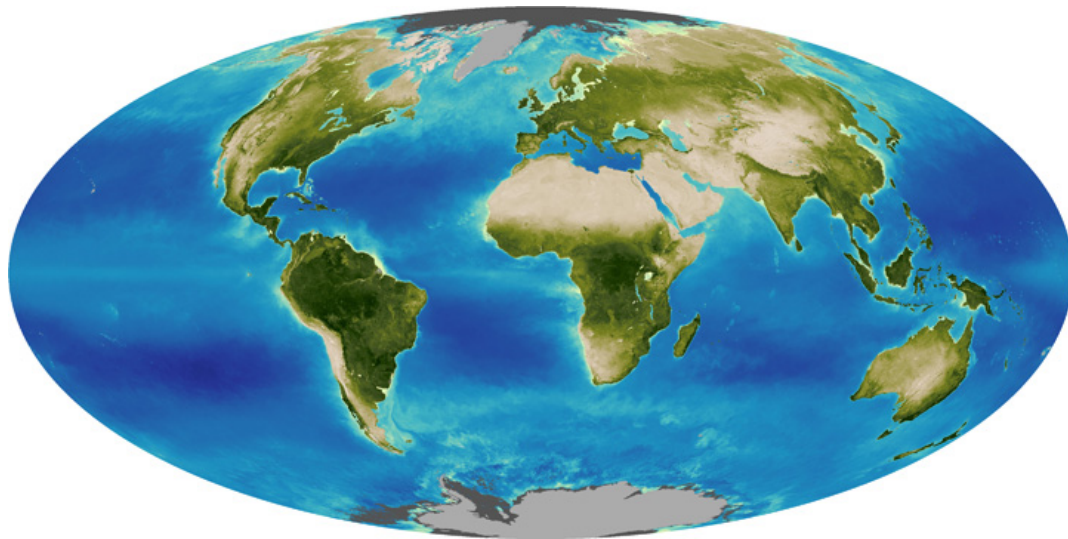

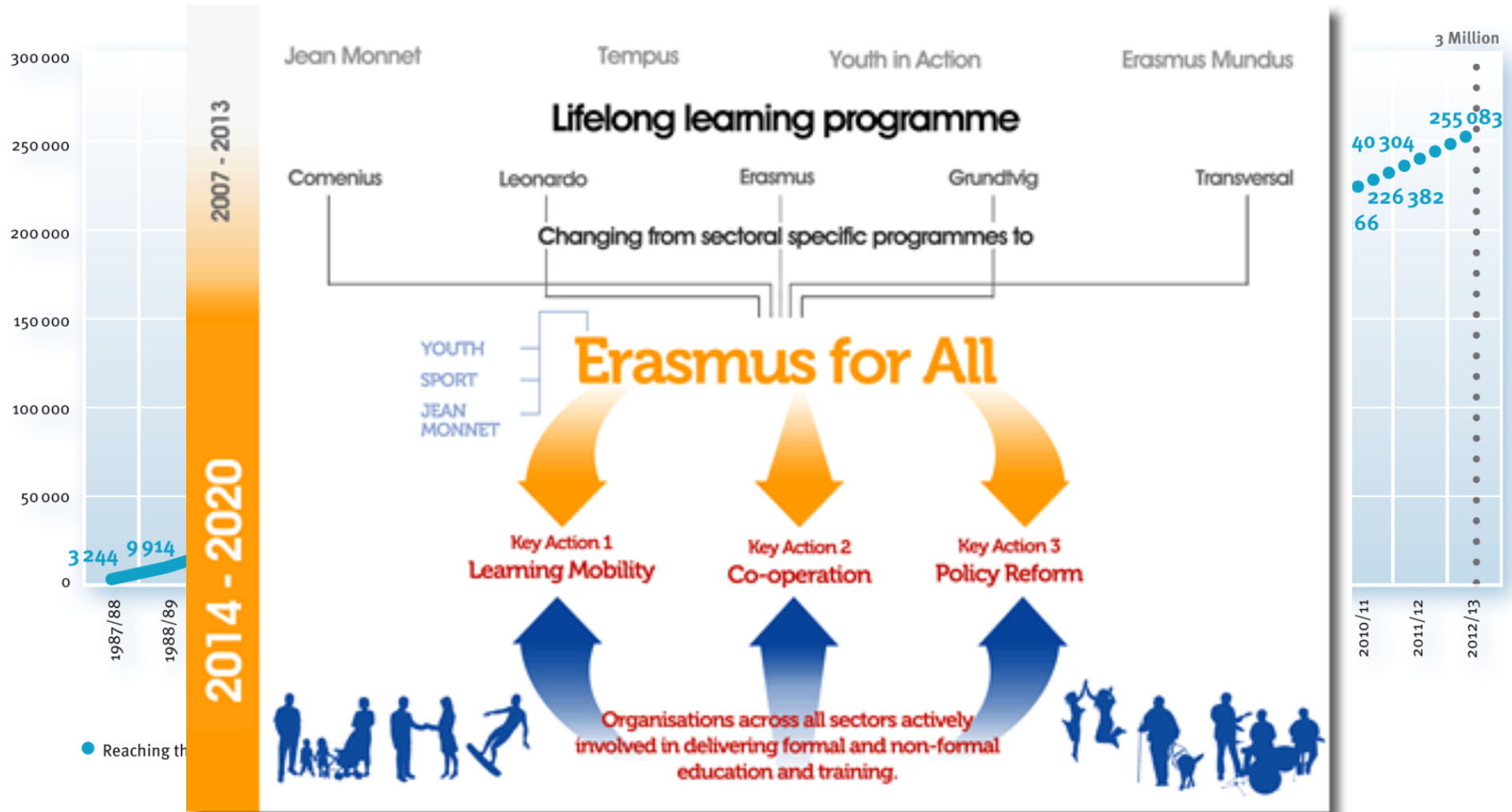

Progress to achieving the 3 million student mobility target



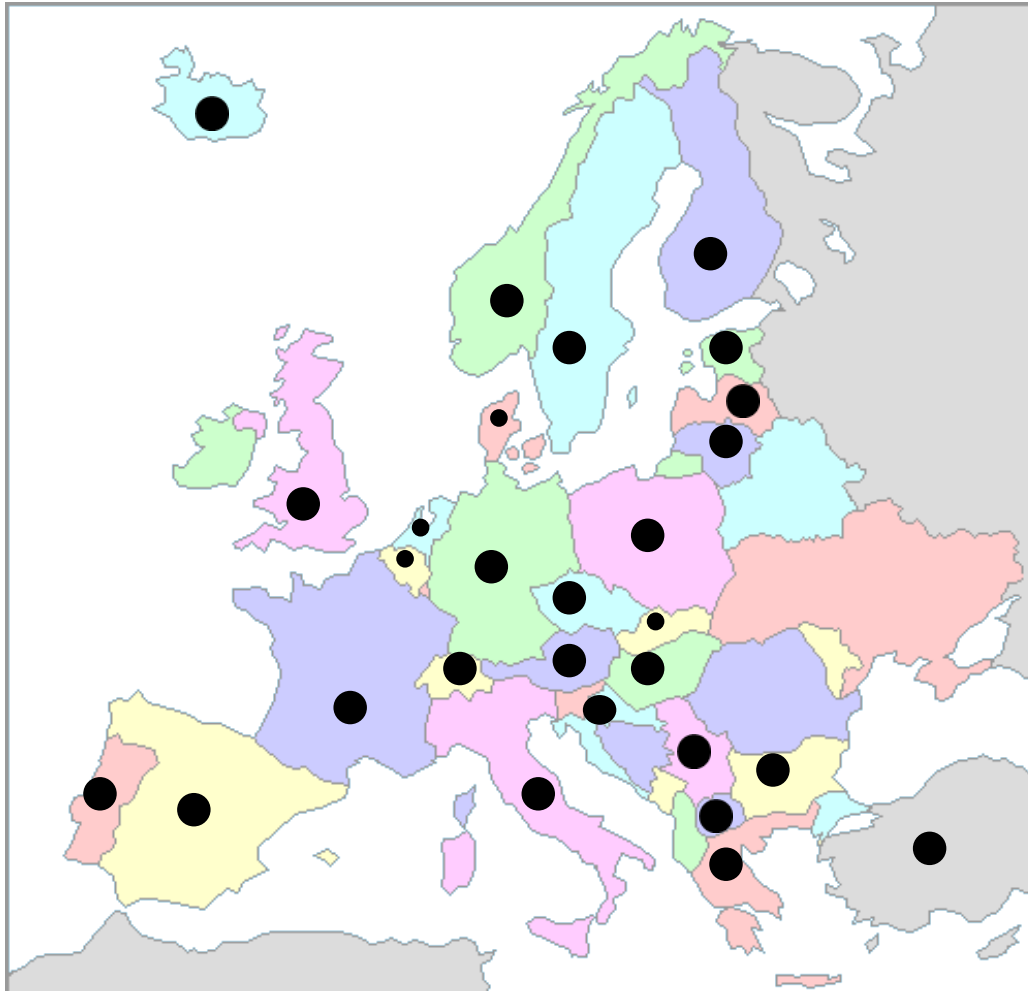

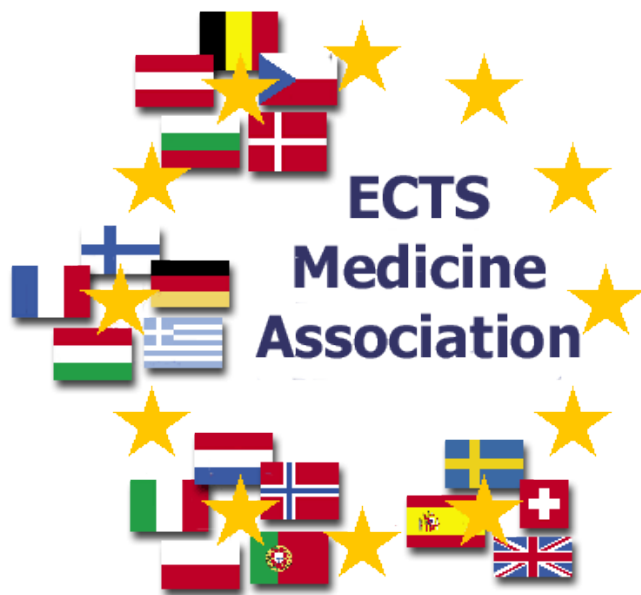
